

## Student Grants Guidelines 2024

Students attending the Graphene Week 2024 and submitting an abstract (as first or second authors) may apply for student grants from the Graphene Flagship. Please read the application requirements and follow the instructions (see below). Incomplete or not eligible applications will not receive funding.

The student grant program aims to support the professional development of students in the field of graphene research. It plays an important role in fostering the next generation of researchers and the growth of the flagship community.

Eligible students may apply to receive a **300 Euros reduction** of the delegates' fee. Only early-bird and normal applications will be considered for the Graphene Week 2024 student grant.

Student grants are available for a limited number of students (**75**) planning to attend Graphene Week 2024.

### Eligibility

To apply for a student grant, you must meet the following criteria:

- Enrolled as a Bachelor's, Master's, or PhD student involved in graphene and related materials research.
- Affiliated with a research institution or organization.
- Proficient in English.

### Application Requirements

- Submit an abstract clearly stating the author(s) names and affiliations through the abstract form.
- For second author applicants, include a statement detailing your contribution to the project.
- Ensure that the abstract content aligns with the topic description in the call.
- Gender balance is considered during the evaluation process.

### Application Procedure

- When submitting your abstract for Graphene Week 2024, make sure to indicate your intention to apply for a student grant
- In the same form, submit your support letter as student proof.
- All application materials must be written in English.
- The selection process is based on the abstract content, and a total of 75 student grants are available.

NOTE: Student proof certificates can also be uploaded after submitting your abstract by logging-in in your personal page of the abstract submission system. Student proof must be uploaded no later than **14 June 2024**. **Student grants reductions are applied to both early registration (deadline 6 August) and normal registration (deadline 30 August).**
